The PADI Rescue Diver Course

“Challenging” and “rewarding” best describe the PADI Rescue Diver course. Building upon what you’ve already learned, this course expands on what you already know about how to prevent problems, and how to manage them if they occur.



The Fun Part

The fun part about this course is rising to challenges and mastering them. Most divers find this course both demanding and rewarding, and at the end, say it’s the best course they’ve ever taken.

What You Learn:

- Self rescue
- Recognizing and managing stress in other divers
- Emergency management and equipment
- Rescuing panicked divers
- Rescuing unresponsive divers

Pre-requisites:

To enrol in the PADI Rescue Diver course, you must

- Be 12 years or older
- Have a PADI Adventure Diver certification (or have a qualifying certification from another organization)
- Be trained and current for first aid and CPR within the previous two years – ask about our Emergency First Response courses taught here.

How long does it take?

Once you take home the course manual, you are free to complete the knowledge development portion of the course at your own pace. When you are ready, come in and review your theory with one of our Instructors, and test yourself with the Rescue Exam. A pool session will benefit your in-water learning but you can complete your Rescue course in just four open water training dives, often best held in one weekend to build upon the skills you are learning.
